Then there was Eric Colpus brother of Walt Colpus a dual holder of W8BRS who suffered from arthritis expired in 1928 at Pontiac, Michigan.


Walt Colpus W8BRS became the original manager or Major Domo from Michigan. Oldest member from day one W8ARJ Dr Geo Kirk suffered infantile paralysis, got his schooling from Toledo Medical College. Eula W8CNO and Blanche W8ADU both of Delaware, OH were friends of the CWC, as well as W8DEJ Margie.

Assistant editor **Hugh M. Hossler W8DIK** of Chardon Ohio was a USN WW1 Veteran. He expired in 1931 and is buried at the Chardon Municipal Cemetery. Hugh was paralyzed from an accident he was involved in while serving in the U.S. Navy - Hugh prepared the stencils, prints the bulletin and mails it to the members. His work is done with a finish and neatness that gives no hint of his disability, said young Eric Palmer Jr W2ATZ. Otto Eppers W8EA, requested W8DIK (Hugh Hossler's memorial call) in 1936 and obtained that secondary call for use at the Dimeling Hotel, Clearfield Pa where Otto was employed.
