World War II had Walt overseas in the Pacific with the Signal Corps. The war ended and he started his own parts distributor selling to industrial users. In 1958 he moved to Los Angeles expanding the company coast to coast.

Walt enjoyed world traveling via many cruise ships and made lots of Ham contacts on those cruises. He was able to make visits scheduled via those contacts and many "eyeball QSO's" were made.
